UPDATE:

1. **Safety –Budget Line \$12,500** - working on initiatives with the Police with a bike patrol in the downtown. List of available store fronts were given out to the Police. No start date (May/Jun-Oct), this will depend on man power. Meeting with the Chief week of February 26-28th. Currently we won't have any assistance from the Banks, as their programs are already in place. Our security program will do 3 days cover for 6hrs from April – November. Looking to membership to add in \$50/yr per member to help in our security program.

2. AMO Grant -

Bill Boards – we a have 4 billboards – look at new marketing company to design and get out. Holiday

Holiday Décor – Need to know how many snowflakes need to be repaired and how many more do we want. Looking at the South side of Oak street at the street lamps

Book Nook – changed to Little Library, and we will put on the signage for that, 9 Lives Design for decals for boxes **Banners** – looking at getting banners put up for the Spring

3. **PAAC Update -** Public Art – we have a seat on the PAAC committee. Public Art piece of wrapping the Traffic Boxes (there are 11) Seymour Graphics gave a price of \$700/box. Need to get another quote from Gateway and Price signs

4. GRANTS- we applied for the TWEED Grant for a Mural Tour, and also for the RED Grant – Rural Economic Development for the beautification of the downtown. The Executive Director will be applying for the **All State Foundation Grant** for funds for our security program.
