Brief Statement of Committee area reporting:	Security, Planters, and update on AMO

UPDATE:

1. **Safety –Budget Line item \$12,500** Apr– Nov for 3 nights per week.

Trying to Partner with the Banks – BMO, TD, Scotia – approx.\$15K per partner to give us year round security. Need to also look at partnership with CTS but CTS needs a mentorship with The City Police in order for this to happen. Looking at supplementing this with \$50/yr per business @200 businesses this would give us an extra \$10K per year. Need to chat with Sword Security in regards to the language that is put on their reports as they are distributed to various entities in the City

2. **Planters**– David Schroeder joined us in regards to the type of plants that will be going into the new planters for the Spring/Summer and early Fall –McIntyre Street will have 41 planters with shockwave petunia, shockwave pet purple, green fountain grass; Main Street – tall green fountain grass, calibrachoa conga yellow, and argyranthemum yellow, calibrachoa conga deep blue, salvia Victoria, calibrachoa conga pink, and Angelonia pink = 13 small, 10 medium, 8 large planters. Wooden planters in front of the empty parking lot TBA

3. **Garbage Cans** – City to look after this, trying to find 45 gallon containers to match what is already out.

4. **Recycling** – no capability of picking up for residential. Pizza Pizza and Subway have their own pick ups for cardboard Look to Miller Waste to put a recycling container in each block – places to be determined

5. **Benches** – to be discussed at our March/April Meeting

6. **Mural Tour** – Katie working on the “TWEED GRANT” for community projects to have a Mural Walk in conjunction with the Gallery Hop

7. **Spring Clean** – to be moved out of the Promotion and Marketing Committee to the Beautification and Safety Committee. Date is set for May 31st. BBQ to be paid for out of the Beautification Committee Budget – maybe change up this for the Volunteers

8. **Snowflakes** – need to check out the wiring harness as they come down for replacement before March 31st. Verify with Zach from Gateway Signs. Need costing for taking down the Christmas Decorations before or at the same time as the Snowflakes – for storage – with the Snowflakes or we store. Need to count how many snowflakes we have.
