OBIAA'S 'I BELIEVE' CAMPAIGN


OBIAA (Ontario Business Improvement Area Association) has launched their 'I Believe' campaign.

CYBER INSURANCE: DO YOU NEED IT?

Six questions to consider when buying cyber insurance

- 1. How many records containing personal information does your organization retain or have access to?
- 2. How many records containing sensitive commercial information does your organization retain or have access to?
- 3. What security controls can you put in place to reduce risk of having your system compromised
- 4. Do all portable media and computing devices need to be encrypted?
- 5. What about unencrypted media in the care, custody or control of your third-party service providers?
- 6. Could you make a claim if you were unable to detect an intrusion until several months or years had passed?

SUCCESSFUL GRANT FROM CANADA HEALTHY COMMUNITIES INITIATIVE

Tourism and Travel Small Business Support Grant

The Ontario government is providing one-time payments of \$10,000 to \$20,000 to support eligible small tourism and travel businesses struggling to recover from the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. This grant will support eligible small tourism and travel businesses that did not receive the Ontario Small Business Support Grant (OSBSG), such as travel agents, hotels, motels, resorts, and bed and breakfasts. To qualify, businesses must have fewer than 100 employees and demonstrate they have experienced a minimum 20 per cent revenue decline between 2019 and 2020. <u>DETAILS HERE</u>

• Restaurant & Bar Support Fund

The Restaurant & Bar Support Fund has been launched to provide one-time grants to financially assist food and beverage establishments throughout Ontario. Their target is to raise \$5 million to assist a minimum of 1,000 Ontario food and beverage businesses through 2021. <u>DETAILS HERE</u>







ACCESSING COVID-19 ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The COVID-19 Energy Assistance Program (CEAP) underwent changes to simplify eligibility criteria and additional funds from the Government of Ontario. These changes make it easier for customers, with overdue amounts on their energy bills, to access support. Small business/registered charity customers can receive up to \$1,500—for electricity and natural gas bills, respectively. Funds are limited with applications processed on a first-come, first-serve basis so consumers who may be in need are encouraged to apply as soon as possible. Details here.
