NEED HELP CREATING AN INSTAGRAM PAGE?


<u>If you want assistance setting up an Instagram page for your business, email</u> <u>Amber</u> to set up a date and time.

If you prefer to do it on your own, <u>this article</u> may prove helpful.

Important information:

- Instagram prefers square images 1080 x 1080 px
- Inserting a link into a caption doesn't allow anyone to click on it
- Remember to add a location to your post e.g. North Bay Ontario
- Crisp photos and videos are preferred
- Hashtags are helpful to include at the end of your caption:
 #northbayontario #gatewaytothenorth #northbayontariocanada

You can also use your business name, or create a unique hashtag that you will use in every post.



WANT A 360 VIEW OF YOUR BUSINESS?


GARBAGE PICK UP
