

DOWNTOWN REJUVENATION

A quick note to let you know that this construction project is **NOT A BIG DIG**, as shown in the photo above from 1983. This project is focused on rehabilitating Main Street from Cassells St to Sherbrooke Street and Ferguson Street from Main Street to Oak Street and will include new sidewalks, curb and gutter, asphalt paved roads, updating and adding low voltage electrical power outlets, landscaping (trees, benches, etc.), festoon lighting on Ferguson and a mid-block crossing, retaining walls, handrail, Adding in official, functioning intersection and mid-block pedestrian crosswalks and new traffic lights at Upgrading the Algonquin/Main, Fraser/Main, Ferguson/Main, and Wyld/Main intersections which will provide improved accessibility purposes for persons with disabilities.

In total, there are five blocks included in the rehabilitation project rejuvenation. The construction process will completely finish one block before starting on the next block. There may be some trees to be planted after a block has reopened. The blocks that will be affected are Algonquin and Main West between Cassells and Fraser; Main West between Fraser and Ferguson; Ferguson between Main and Oak; Main East from Ferguson to Wyld and Main East from Wyld to Sherbrooke. 2022 PATIO SEASON

Outdoor Patio Fees Waived for 2022 Season by the City of North Bay!

To help support local businesses, the City of North Bay will again waive all fees associated with the creation of new or expanded outdoor patio spaces for the 2022 season.

First implemented in 2020 and then again in 2021, setting the fees aside again for this year was approved by North Bay City Council Tuesday.

This includes any potential building permit fees, applicable parking fees under the existing Sidewalk Patio Program and municipal alcohol license approvals and extensions issued through the City Clerk's Office.

The existing Sidewalk Patio Program in the Downtown will also be expanded again this season to support the use of sidewalks for outdoor retail space. Guidelines developed by the City to assist local businesses in the creation of new or expanded outdoor patio spaces, including information about when a permit may be required are available at https://www.northbay.ca/OutdoorPatios




GROWTH COMMUNITY INCENTIVE PLAN (GCIP)
