## HOUSEKEEPING

### PATIO SEASON IS COMING TO A CLOSE

We're nearing October, and cooler weather will be here to stay. Remember that patios can stay up until the Thanksgiving long weekend in October.

### FILMING ON OAK WEST SEPTEMBER 27TH

On Tuesday, September 27th, from approx 8AM to 4PM, we will be filming Exterior daytime scenes on the sidewalk on Oak St near Lou Dawgs and our first Interior Location at Rogers Jewellers at 154 Oak St W. We have approx 6 hours of work on the sidewalk, and inside the jewellers.

During these scenes, we'll need to implement Intermittent Traffic Stoppages (ITS) on OAK ST W btwn Fraser & Ferguson at various times btwn approx 9AM & 4PM.

During our Prep & Wrap days, we will need to control several of the Parking spaces on Oak St W btwn Fraser & Ferguson. On filming day, we will need to control all of the spaces as they will be seen on camera, with Picture Vehicles on theme with our show.

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## **FILMING ON MAIN WEST SEPTEMBER 26-28**

Monday through Wednesday next week Christmas at the Drive-In will be filming on Main West around the Annex, the alleyway, Framemaker and Opera Bakery. The production will be collecting signatures.

The production will be renting the parking spaces throughout Main West. They will be using foam for fake snow.

On Tuesday, September 27th, there will be intermittent traffic stoppages.

Thursday through Saturday, they will be filming at St. Andrews Church, and will take up parking on Algonquin.

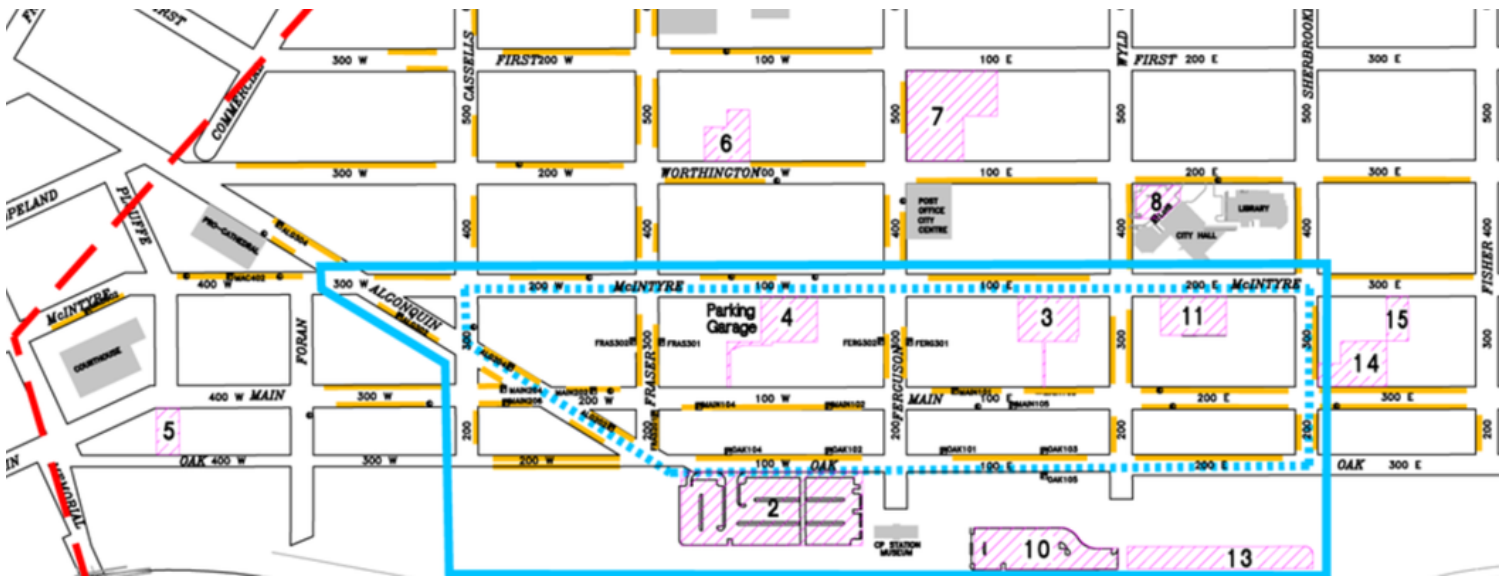
