

2023 PATIO SEASON

The City of North Bay has adopted the Sidewalk Patio Policy in order to grant businesses in the Downtown Improvement Area the opportunity to apply to receive non-exclusive use of publicly owned sidewalks and on-street parking spaces in front of their buildings to permit the establishment of sidewalk patios. Sidewalk patios will be permitted from the Victoria Day long weekend in May to the Thanksgiving long weekend in October. The establishment of sidewalk patios will enhance the downtown streetscape, helping to create an inviting and vibrant area where residents and visitors will want to spend time.

REMINDER:

If you are renting parking spaces for your patio, you must enter a new agreement each year with the municipality.

SECURITY & PARKING ENFORCEMENT

Security/parking authority what can they do on the street?

Parking enforcement is separate from security personnel; not all individuals have their security license.

Those with security licenses cannot physically remove individuals in Downtown; their duties include monitoring and reporting. They can ask someone to move along. If an individual requires to be physically moved, police must be called.
