

Patio season is almost here.

Reminder: You will need to apply for your patio with the City of North Bay.

Should the **Sidewalk Patio Application be approved, the Applicant will be** required to enter into a standard **Sidewalk Patio Agreement** with the City of North Bay. At that time the **Applicant will be require to provide the following:** 

- A Certificate of Insurance for public liability (personal injury and property damage insurance) in the minimum amount of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) naming the Corporation of the City of North Bay as an additional insured.
- A Certificate issued by the Workplace Safety and Insurance Board.
- The Rental Fee of \$100 per parking space per month the patio is installed (if applicable)
- A PIN Sheet for subject property

IMPORTANT: The <u>parking rental fee</u> for the sidewalks does come <u>back in to</u> <u>affect this year</u>. It would be <u>\$100/space/month</u>.


